• **Pre-Departure Payment:** An additional 30% payment must be completed at least 30 days before your safari departure date.

• **Final Balance:** The remaining 50% balance can be paid upon arrival in Tanzania in cash.

CANCELLATION POLICY

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

• **Passport** must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your travel dates

• **Visa** required for most nationalities - obtain online (eVisa) or upon arrival

• **Travel insurance** mandatory - must cover medical evacuation and trip cancellation

• **Yellow fever vaccination** required if traveling from endemic countries

• **Malaria prophylaxis** recommended - consult your doctor before travel

• **Packing:** Comfortable neutral-colored clothes for daytime, warm layers for early mornings/evenings

• **Accommodations** subject to availability - similar or higher category may be substituted

• **Order of national parks** may change due to logistics and wildlife movements

BEST TIME TO VISIT

â€¢ June - October (Dry Season): Best wildlife viewing, animals gather around water sources

â€¢ July - September: Great Migration river crossings in Northern Serengeti (Mara River)

â€¢ December - March (Calving Season): Wildebeest calving in Southern Serengeti, high predator activity

â€¢ January - February: Best time for bird watching, migratory birds present

â€¢ March - May (Wet Season): Green landscapes, fewer crowds, lower rates

â€¢ Zanzibar: Best visited June - March (warm and sunny year-round)
